



WHAT IS THE NEW MEPP?

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The Manitoba Enhanced Pharmacare Program (MEPP) is a new government initiative that provides free coverage of many commonly prescribed medications for eligible Manitobans. This program allows us to provide the same great service you've come to expect, at no charge!

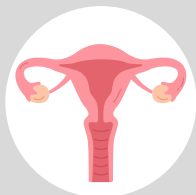
Who is Eligible?

You qualify for MEPP if you:

- Have an active Manitoba Health card, and:
- If you do not have 100% coverage through a federal or other provincial drug program

What's Covered?

MEPP covers most prescription medications for:



Birth Control



Diabetes



HIV



Hormone Replacement Therapy (HRT)



Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need to pay upfront to get reimbursed?

- No. The medication and dispensing fee are directly covered under MEPP.

Do I need to meet my Pharmacare deductible first?

- No. MEPP is separate from the Manitoba Pharmacare deductible program.

Are my medications covered?

HOW THE NEW MEPP PROGRAM WORKS

1. Get a prescription from your healthcare provider for an eligible medication.
2. Bring your Manitoba Health card and prescription to the Pharmacy.
3. We'll take care of the rest. If eligible, you won't pay for the medication or the dispensing fee.

- MEPP covers the cost of eligible medications up to the lowest cost interchangeable price.
- This program covers a maximum of one dispensing per month for diabetes, hormone replacement, and HIV, and a maximum of one dispensing every 3 months for birth control.
- Most prescriptions can be filled for up to 100 days.
